• After many years without any community alert system, the Benicia CAN system was installed in 2001.

 7 large sirens were mounted on poles strategically placed throughout the community.



CHALLENGES WITH THE BENICIA CAN SYSTEM

- No information to citizens who were away from their TVs or radios.
- Difficult to update messages
- Power issues
- Volume
- Software Issues






System Upgrade

- Major upgrade in 2016
- The Benicia Fire Department partnered with Everbridge to add **AlertBenicia**
- The siren activation software was changed.
- Power issues were addressed

WIRELESS EMERGENCY ALERTS CAPABLE

How does it work

- Anyone who lives or works in Benicia to register for emergency alerts
- Registrants can opt-in to receive alerts via
 - Mobile phone
 - Land line phone
 - SMS text device
 - Email
 - Everbridge app
 - TTY / TTD Device
- The system is also capable of sending WEA Alerts



How does it work (cont.)

 Registrants select one or more locations based on address. (home, work, school, etc.)

 Notifications can be targeted based on locations on a map.

• Allows the notifications to be sent independent or in conjunction with the community sirens.



What Alerts Can be Sent?

Get important updates about:

- Natural or Human Made Disasters
- Evacuations
- Floods
- Lockdowns
- Missing Persons
- Major Power Outages
- Road Closures
- Severe Weather
- Utility Failures
- And Much More!
