• Tonight's Agenda and minutes from the 8/27/24 meeting were approved.

Refinery Update

- Lauren Bird, Vice President & General Manager
 - The FCC Unit's main blower has been having mechanical issues for the past 6 weeks and we are working with many contractors to get this important unit fixed. Our Cat Feed Hydrotreater

is also being worked on due to planned maintenance. Due to the extra activity during the turnaround, today's refinery driving tour will not visit the Water Utilities area of the refinery.

- There was a recent consent decree signed between San Francisco Baykeeper, Valero & Amports due to the alleged discharge of petroleum coke in 2022. The total settlement amount between both Valero and Amports was ~\$2.4MM and we expect that there will be media coverage of the settlement. It was noted that Amports has the Air District permit for the coke operation at the dock.
- On Thursday, our employees will conclude the United Way Employee Giving campaign in which ~\$463,000 has been raised from employee pledges. These donations will be distributed through United Way to local charities. Valero published our annual <u>ESG</u> Report that highlights our corporation's Environment Social and Governance priorities. Copies of the Report were distributed.
- Melissa Manke-Fimbres, Health, Safety, Environmental & Regulatory Affairs Director
 - Melissa mentioned that the refinery is working with the Solano County Hazardous Materials department regarding odors that occurred in February related to issues with one of our tanks. Once that information has been finalized, it will be published onto the City of Benicia's Public Information Bank website. We are working with the city to receive permits for the Phase 4 Pathway of the Fenceline project and resolve language affiliated with the easement agreement.

 - Paul highlighted content on the <u>Valero Benicia Refinery Public Relations website</u>.
