Meeting Recap

March 10, 2020

The CAP received a quarterly update about refinery operations, health, safety, environmental, and community affairs from refinery personnel. An 'Energy Matters – Refining 101 Series' video was shown about <u>crude oil</u> <u>distillation</u>. Benicia's Fire Chief demonstrated how to access content on the city's <u>Public Information Bank</u> website.

July 14, 2020

The CAP welcomed new Vice President and General Manager, Josh Tulino. Members received a quarterly update about refinery operations, HSE issues and responses to COVID-19 and an <u>overview</u> of community donations that occurred. A video showing the installation of flare gas recovery compressor project was presented.
